Follow these simple steps:

If you choose to make your #EnCasa story via video, here are some tips to help you record your story:

- Choose a location in your home that is well lit.
- Gather around members of your family to answer the questions.
- Make sure to test your video and audio before recording.
- Talk about what you will say, assign parts of the story to any participants.
- Rehearse it a couple of times on video to see how it looks to you.
- Try and use a stand or tri-pod to keep the camera from shaking too much.
- Keep your video under three minutes.
